Thanks to everyone for the encouragement and support in my new project. I can see now why time constraints dissuaded Todd and Cathy from continuing. Many thanks to them for the time they spent putting out the Bulletin. I apologize that this edition is late. Todd and Cathy published with a Microsoft program called Publisher. I don't have that program. The club would have bought me one (for \$170 American, \$6,000 Canadian) but I thought I would try another program to save the club the money. Therefore I have been setting up the basic structure in Word and converted what existing documents I could. That wasn't many so I have had to redo them. That also means it will look a little different than before. It will probably take me a while to get everything adjusted and set up better.

The one thing I did was to give all the Lancaster, PA show results. Colour classes, Class winners and points. I have always liked to see who is doing what at the shows. Not just the winners. It's interesting to see the progress people have made in the show cages. Let me know what you think of that format. ### Riches to Rags by Dennis Bray



Coming home from the DesMoines National as the winner of Plain Heads and Short Face I was very full of enthusiasm about my breeding program. With the timing of the National this year I could come home and begin mating my Helmets a month earlier.

My first decision was which variety do I start with? After determining which variety was most likely to produce more winners I started with Plain Heads. I then mated Short Face and finished with Medium Faced. Once the pairs were mated up and moved into the breeding pens the **DISASTER** began!!

Birds started to get sick. Diarrhea created a very wet loft. The birds were not eating and I started to lose birds I had entered at the National. My luck got worse and I lost both my National Champions. It progressed and I was losing up to 5 Helmets a day.

I called Kevin Zollars and we decided it that it was Paratyphoid. I started treating with Baytril. Five days into treatment the birds were not improving and I was still losing helmets. It moved into my Rollers and White Racing Homers. Nothing was safe except for the pigeons I had purchased from other breeders.

I called those breeders and sure enough they had vaccinated for Avian Paramyxovirus. It was PMV I had been hit with. I called Kevin again and we agreed that we had better vaccinate as soon as possible. After vaccinating my entire loft I was still losing pigeons. After a week I noticed that the droppings were getting firm and the loft was drying out. The pigeons started to eat again. Cocks started showing signs of mating and chasing hens. I ended up losing more than 2 thirds of my pigeons. Years of breeding had vanished! I had only 1 of 8 Plain Head cocks left. It was very sad and tough to deal with.



Fellow Breeders. The point is to make sure you vaccinate your birds every year. Don't let all your hard work go into the garbage can. It really hurts.

Looks like our foreign neighbors to the North are becoming more interested in getting involved in the States. The Western Sectional being judged by Gary Parsons from Ontario. Giulio Marcoccia showed at Louisville and the National. I must say, this Canadian breeder put some fear in us American breeders. Giulio came with an impressive show team. With the National being held near Detroit, Michigan next year I am sure there will be more Helmets shown from Canada.

The DesMoines National is over. In this breeders eyes it was a successful show. The entries were down this year, yet the quality of Helmets in all varieties was good. Those AHA members who did not support this National missed a good N.P.A. pigeon show. Total entries were over 8,000 pigeons. The show hall was plenty large to support the number of entries. It was a great show hall to support this type of event. Fred Smith walked in and sat down in the Helmet section to visit and reminisce about all the long time Helmet breeders. Fred Smith and Myron Berger were real good competitors in the short face during the 60's and 70's. In addition they were very active in the Helmet club during those years.

I must address the poor sportsmanship that I have seen the last several years pertaining to the selection of champions at our Nationals. I feel it damages the image of our club. It is also disrespectful to the judge and the breeders of the champion helmets. It is a great honor to be chosen champion and when another member carries on about the wrong bird winning it sure takes a lot of excitement away from the winning breeder. Both times this happened it was a master breeder making a statement regarding poor judging and the wrong Helmet being picked. Is it so important for you breeders counting your master breeder points to show this kind of sportsmanship? This breeder/showman would be willing to do away with the master breeder award if it is going to induce our members to act in this way when they don't get the master breeder points they feel they were cheated out of. Get used to losing. There's lots of new competition out there. They are good breeders raising good helmets.

The champion MFC, a black young cock, owned and bred by Raul Delgado was an outstanding Helmet. Raul, who is not a first time National winner, has to be very proud of this win. Don Phy had reserve with a very good black old cock and Giulio Marcoccia got third with a beautiful silver cock.

The Plain head champion was a powerful yellow old cock owned by myself. Reserve went to Bob Dunlap with a good colored blue old cock. A nice yellow hen won third for Giulio Marcoccia.

There were 10 short face shown, which is not enough for a point show. Even so, this variety is receiving more attention and it is becoming more difficult to win a short face champion award. I won with a red young cock and Bob Dunlap picked up reserve with a red old cock. I received third with a red old hen.

We did not hold an auction at this show because of the lack of available birds. This is one reason we are seeing new winners and breeders. There has been a lot of good quality Helmets available for sale.

Good luck in the breeding pens. Remember to help support our new bulletin editor.
