Committee to review the Master Breeder program

The AHA Master Breeder program has served us well for a long time. However, over the last year or so I have talked with a number of people about facets of our program. In many cases we have members who are not aspiring to win the award because they feel it is unattainable. There are other members who are frustrated by some of the current requirements. After reflecting on these discussions I have decided to appoint a committee to study the program and make recommendations to the board of directors prior to the San Diego National.

Obviously this is a notable event for us as the Master Breeder program has not been altered in the last several decades. Being a Master Breeder myself I also do not dilute the prestige of the award. However, we no longer live in the days of several hundred bird shows and lots of events throughout the country. Perhaps it is time to re-evaluate things in light of our current realities and adjust the program to make it once again attainable with similar rigor what an individual would have experienced 20 years ago. With a renewed program, I am hopeful that we will see a renewed interest in people aspiring to attain the award. This should lead to larger shows and a grass roots push to get in show reports to the club!

Here are some thoughts that we may want to consider;

- Reduce the minimum number of birds for points at a show
- Reduce the threshold for the various varieties (i.e. for MFC reduce point requirement from 1500 points to 1000 points)
- Insert an "or" with the requirement to have won a National to state the individual has won a national or has won 2x or 3x best YB or Yearling at Nationals
- Change minimum number of birds for point show

My key principles for the committee;

- Make the Master Breeder Award more achievable in realities of today's helmets
- Maintain the challenging principles of the award as envisioned at its inception
- Ensure that are facets of the program which provide incentive for members to show more birds at more events
- Provide broad and clear communication of the thoughts and proposed changes

- Maintain a robust, thoughtful and data based program which other clubs look up to as a model

I have informally talked to many people over the last several months. In the next few weeks I will be contacting several of you individually as I appoint the committee. I plan to represent all regions, long time members, current master breeders and those aspiring to the win the award.

About six years ago, we published our first product catalogue. That was after being in the pigeon supply business for 14 years. It consisted of 16 pages. Two years later, our second catalogue was out, it was forty pages in length. They are all gone and we have experienced a surge in business and have increased our inventory considerably. We are now working on catalogue #3 which I expect to be sixty plus pages long. The days of a simple price list are long gone!

Our newest catalogue will be the usual 8 1/2 X 11 with a very attractive color cover, back cover and inside covers of heavy, high gloss paper. We printed 3000 of our first catalogue and 5000 of the second. This time I expect to circulate up to 10,000 copies. A catalogue is included in all of our shipments and a long list of requests will be satisfied.

Many requests come from novices, hungry for breed information and contacts as well as serious breeders just looking for other options. As you probably know, product catalogues are kept and referred to many times. They are also shared with friends. Once again I am giving friends, associates and businesses an opportunity to place an ad in our catalogue.

We are offering three ad sizes, the inside front cover and the inside and outside back cover. Black & white ads are \$50.00 for a quarter page, \$75.00 for a half page and \$125.00 for a full page. Color ads are \$65.00 for a quarter page, \$90.00 for a half page and \$150.00 for a full page. Both covers are glossy color. The inside front cover will be \$180.00. The back cover will cost \$190.00, and the inside back cover \$165.00.

I think you will agree that these are very reasonable rates. Your ad would be included should we have a second printing.

Dipping Problems

Earlier this year I had a huge disappointment as I lost quite a few birds after dipping them for mites. I dipped them with the same products in the same manner that I have for years. Unfortunately, this year, at about 1-2 days after the dipping I started losing birds. After a lot of calls and research I learned that many people (not just pigeons) have been starting to see pesticide toxicity in animals. There is a belief that pesticide vendors are changing their formulations and concentrations to help keep their products effective as insects are starting to get resistant to the products. The changes they are making also affect our host animals as we use the products. In my discussions I learned that it is best to use only Sevin dust on the birds. I have been using that ever since spring and I have had good results.

3. Sale coops are pretagged at the cost of \$20.00 each, 8 bird limit each.
4. Sale coops are for rent to exhibitors only and are for pigeons and doves only. No dealers please. Exhibitors are limited to 3 sales coops and must be paid for with entry. **NO FOR SALE COOPS AVAILABLE AT THE SHOW.**
5. Remove carrying cases from show hall after cooping birds.
6. Please make checks payable to: NATIONAL YOUNG BIRD SHOW.
7. Mail all entries to: NYBS, P.O. BOX 21, MILTON, KY 40045.
8. Classes will be provided for young cock and young hen only.
9. Please read all instructions, special rules and times, color explanations, etc. that may be listed with the specialty club's awards list.
10. The Louisville Pigeon Club, Inc., nor its representative will be responsible for any loss, damage, accident or death to any exhibit during the show. Every precaution will be taken.
11. Watchmen will be on duty Friday night ONLY.
12. The show hall will close to visitors and exhibitors Friday at 10 p.m.
13. The NYBS has the right to remove any unhealthy specimen.
14. If for any reason the NYBS is cancelled or postponed, the Louisville Pigeon Club, Inc., is not responsible for travel, hotel or any lost money. All show fees would be refunded.
15. Reception of entries will begin at **NOON** on **FRIDAY** and continue until 9 a.m. Saturday.
16. The judging times may be staggered due to limited judging areas.
17. All entries must be cooped by 9 a.m. Saturday.
18. All decisions of the judges shall be final.
19. The NYBS has the right to disqualify any exhibitor.
20. The NYBS Committee has the final judgement on questions regarding any and all parts of this show.
21. By submitting an entry to this show you agree to follow all rules.

25. Sale birds must be placed in the For Sale Section.
26. List all information on your entry (color number, full band number, etc.) Mark all JUNIOR entries.
27. All substitutions must be made at secretary's table prior to judging.

28. No birds are allowed in the show coops unless entry fee has been paid on those birds.
29. No entries after the POSTMARK closing date of October 6, 2010.
