At our San Diego board of directors meeting, we unanimously approved a resolution to give Chuck this "Outstanding Achievement Award" as a small token of the club's great appreciation for all of his hard work. This year we had another great National. It was wonderful to see such a diverse representation of our membership at the show. We had members from all regions, many old friends, and lots of new members. Steve Petito did an excellent job with our MFC judging. It is noteworthy that Steve wasn't showing birds and came cross country to the show just to help the club. Thanks Steve! We had two junior members (Ty and Zachary) who showed nice birds and were genuinely interested and engaged in the show. I look forward to great things from these guys in the future. It was also nice to meet Bob and Mickey Jackson from District 4. These guys have been club members for some time but I haven't had the opportunity to meet them before. I know they left the auction with some very nice stock. I hope their breeding goes well and we see them at future Nationals and district meets. We had a productive board of directors meeting and a great auction. Once again, the auction helped spread out a lot of good helmets and provided a nice boost to our treasury.

Along with our typical awards, I am pleased to report that I gave Mike LaCom a special "President's Award" at the National. Mike has worked hard and contributed a lot of his own money to make lights, stands, and accessories that he transports to our Western events. Our judging areas are amongst the best at the shows and look very classy. His work makes the AHA look very proud! Thanks Mike. I also sent special award certificates to our juniors. Both of them had very respectable birds that deserved recognition. In our BOD meeting we agreed to award "Small Loft" and "Best Yearling" certificates. With all busy activity at the show we were not able to coordinate these. If anyone believes that they meet the small loft criteria (<6 pairs) or had a yearling high in one of the final line-ups, let me know and I will coordinate these and get them out.

It was refreshing to see the teamwork at the National. Members helped set up our area, transport each other to the airport, and re-arrange birds. This all helped things run smoothly. I want to especially thank Hank and Tony. I chose to make a quick road trip to visit my 1st grandchild, who arrived the Friday of the show, so I was not able to be present for our general membership meeting or the auction. Hank did a great job of running our meeting and Tony meticulously took care of the book work and money for our auction. As usual, Dennis Manning did a great job as our auctioneer. Thanks to all!

We did encounter a bit of a conundrum at the National. In our MFC variety Vic Cline showed a very nice black OC bred by Giulio Marcoccia. This bird went on to win the show. This is the first time in anyone's recollection that a bought bird won a National event. At the show and after the event members engaged in a lively discussion regarding the appropriate recognition of the win in the context of our master breeder program. The current wording of the program is clear with respect to master breeder points but the wording on recognition of the win, to meet master breeder requirements, appears to contradict the points direction. Obviously this ambiguity is frustrating to most everyone and has caused a fair amount of consternation. I am pleased to share that Giulio called me and offered to withdraw his request that the bird be recognized for the master breeder criteria. Giulio's selfless offer is very helpful in minimizing this distraction to the club and allows us to move forward with tidying up the program to avoid future discussion. Giulio has fabulous birds and I am confident that we will see him winning many future events.

I am also pleased to report that helmets are continuing getting attention from folks outside of North America. We all see our international friends on our "MyFamily" web site. But even beyond the web, I

received a separate request for a copy of our standard for inclusion into the German standards book. This is a very prestigious request and I was proud to share our standard. I asked for a copy of the finished translation, just so we could all see the final product in a future bulletin.

As we look to our officer transitions. There are a few updates to the list. Mike LaCom and Leonard Patito decided to swap the District 1 Director role and Guilio decided to step down from Publicity Director. Dennis Manning graciously stepped up to take on the Publicity Director role so our slate is again full.

Indeed the past few months have been very busy and I want to thank everyone for their calls of support. Your well wishes are greatly appreciated.

> Volunteers Needed! Master Breeder Revision Committee By Bob Bollinger

As many of you know there has been a lot of discussion about our master breeder program. The discussion started last year when I appointed a committee to review our current program and provide recommendations for changes in the light of our current club size and bird entries. Most of you are also aware of the challenge we recently encountered when a bought bird won the MFC competition at the San Diego National. While there was a diversity of thought and passion about how we should handle that situation, the one thing that everyone agreed on was the fact that we need to clarify our program so there is no ambiguity or misunderstanding in the future.

So, moving forward I am sun-setting our initial committee and re-chartering a new committee with an expanded scope. We still need to consider things like entry numbers and class sizes but I also request the new committee to take an in depth look at our overall master breeder document. Think about each rule and its current and long term implications. Also consider what we really want to focus on in our program. Is the program a combination of breeding, showing and service? Do we want to have different programs for master breeder and master showman? There are a lot of facets to consider and I need everyone to move forward thoughtfully.

I am looking for up to 5 volunteers to form this new committee. I would like to see representation from different regions, varying tenure in the club, with both current master breeders and those aspiring to the award. The expectation of committee members is to not only review the program but also interface with other club members in your area. Understand their thoughts and desires and lobby for the final committee recommendation. In this way we are assured of concurrence and an easy voting process to ratify the changes. On a personal note, it would also help me if someone on the committee is computer savvy such that the final recommendations are typed and presented in a digital format.

The meeting was called to order; January 8, 2011, 10:00 AM by Western VP, Hank Ebbelaar.

Members reviewed the attached Board of Directors Meeting Minutes and Treasurers Report. Members were asked to make special note of the "Outstanding Achievement" Award being given to Chuck for his 18 Years of service as AHA Secretary Treasurer.

VP Hank Ebbelaaar announced that Mike LaCom will be receiving a special "President's Award" from the Club. Mike did a great job transporting and setting up our area here and has been instrumental in doing the same at many of the recent Western events. We were blessed to have two great junior members showing with us at the show. Members agreed to use the results of the NPA junior judging to award our Junior Champion.

Members were reminded of the AHA auction immediately following the general membership meeting. Members engaged in a lively discussion regarding the wording and original intent of the AHA Master Breeder Rule requirement for a nominee to have won the National. The MFC winner at this show was exhibited by a club member but the bird was bred by another member. To the best of everyone's recollection this is the first time this has occurred in the history of the AHA. Since there was a lot of discussion in the aisles during the show and recognizing that there was a broad diversity (regions, tenure, master breeders, past officers, charter member, etc) of officers and membership present at the meeting, President Bob Bollinger left a request the members discuss this emergent issue and provide a consensus of opinion on the matter. After much consideration;

A motion was made by Dennis Manning, Second by Hank Ebbelaar to summarize the opinion of the collective as follows; "We agree that the present rules state that to get credit for the Master Breeder requirement a nominee must win the National with a bird he exhibits and has bred."

Motion passed. (all in favor with 2 abstain, none opposed)

Meeting was adjourned to move forward with the auction.

Officer's Reports

President's Report – Bob Bollinger

Our club is doing well! Our core membership is holding steady and our show events are doing great. This year we had sectional meets in a three sections with 8 point shows overall in 5 districts. Thanks go out to everyone who worked to hold and attend our events. As always, our members had a good time at the events and people took notice of our great club and group of people.

We had a great club election this year with nearly a full slate of officers on the ballot and numerous nominations for judges. It was especially noteworthy that we had many people step up to take on roles in the club. There was even some lobbying as people aspired to hold roles. This is a far cry from some years in the past where we had to go out and beg people to hold office and judge. We had a good number of our members vote in the election and a number of close votes. For the roles without nominations, several people accepted appointments to the open District Director roles.

I am especially pleased to report that we had several volunteers to take on our Secretary / Treasurer role. Chuck has done an outstanding job over the last 18 years and the AHA owes him our deepest thanks. Greg Bliven won the role and I have been in contact with both Chuck and Greg. We have started shifting club business to Greg and we have also created a number of check lists to help ensure a smooth transition.

This year I appointed a committee to review our current Master Breeder rules and recommend any changes required in light of changes in the hobby over the last few decades. District 7 Report – Bob Bollinger

District 14 Report – Vic Cline

It looks like we will get a new member in North Carolina and hopefully generate more interest in the Maryland area as two former members have expressed an interest in getting back into helmets. Old Business from last year:

Numbers of bands – BOD agrees with Chuck's recommendation to go with 3000 bands this year. Size 7mm. We also need to remind people to use AHA bands and register others. Motion to accept by Dennis Manning second by Hank Ebbelaar. Approved

Need money approved for club web sites (AHA \$69 and My Family~\$60) – BOD recommends we pay for the sites. BOD also reminds members to be positive and use the tools to help benefits the club and the breed. Motion to accept by Dennis Manning second by Victor Cline. Approved

Email bulletins -everyone remind Greg if you wish to receive via email - This will reduce Paul's work and the club's copying / postage costs. We would also like to encourage Greg and officers to reach out to everyone and advocate the email bulletin.

Message board on the AHA web site – A "Birds for Sale" and "Birds Wanted" message board has been added to the AHA web site. BOD recommends that we continue with this as a service to the AHA members for helmets only. Motion to accept Steve Mitchell and second by Hank Ebbelaar. Approved. Do we want to do an Auction at this event? - BOD determined that we will do it at 11A Saturday after the General Membership meeting. We encourage members to minimize selling in the aisles and help support the auction.

New Business

Timely Submission of Show Reports – BOD to brainstorm what we can do to get results submitted in proper format in to proper places in a timely manner.

Clarification of Breeder of the Year – BOD unanimously voted to approve the committee recommendation to clarify the Breeder of the Year award to specify "by variety".

Officer Appointments – President Bob B reported that he appointed the following people to fill club positions not filled in the election; Steve Mitchell – Dist. 8 Director, Wes Pfadenhauer – Dist. 3 Director, and Pavel Lutsenko – Dist. 9 Director. Greg Bliven will be opening a new AHA bank account as part of his transition from Chuck and is authorized to do so.

Outstanding Achievement Award – President Bob B nominated Chuck Dwight to receive a special outstanding achievement award from the AHA for his 18 years of service as AHA Secretary / Treasurer. Chuck will receive a certificate and special glass award. The BOD unanimously concurred with this.

SSL and Yearling Awards – Bob B recommended that we provide a SSL (supporting the small loft) award certificate again this year, if applicable, and also provide Champion Yearling certificates for each of our major classes. Dennis Manning made a motion to accept the recommendation second by Victor Cline. Approved.

Use of AHA bands – BOD to encourage all members in their districts to buy and band with AHA bands. The bands are the primary revenue generator for the club and having bands left over has a major impact on our treasury.

Ad in the Purebred – BOD recommends that we continue our ad in the Purebred as current. Motions to accept by Hank Ebbelaar second by Steve Mitchell. Approved. Early Mailing of Bands to Canada – Giulio noted that the mailing of bands to Canada can take longer than expected and requested that we mail them earlier. He suggests December 10 like the NPA sends. Motion by to accept by Steve Mitchell second by Steve Petitio.

Web Site Thread Capture - Bob B suggested that we ask someone to monitor web traffic and capture good threads for publication in the bulletin and AHA web sites. The BOD humbly requests Giulio to do it as it fits well with the Publicity Director role.
