A reminder of by-gone days

Description of the German Helmet

Recent articles concerning Helmeis have brought back memories of the year 1894 when I had some Helmets of my own. The city where I spent most of my life was only six miles from Hamburg: so we children bred the local varieties of Hamburgs. I nev-er knew that they were called Plotten-

tumblers until I read a recent article, we always called tham Calottes.
The first time I saw Short-Faced Helmets, was in 1916, and I grew very ford of these nice looking birds, but they were very scarce and hard to get.
In 1924, when I came to this country, I tried to bring some along, but they were still hard to get, so instead I brought my Statiner Tumblers and Danaiger Highfliers. After I read an article about Helmets I wondered what the "German Standard" had to any about them, and discovered some very interesting information.
The Hamburger Calotte or Helmet is a typical Hamburger Calotte or all others in Hamburger and surrounding cities. The Short-Paced Helmet, and discovered some very interesting information.

in flight performance, petite in body, and lively in action, it makes a very remarkable impression.

The markings look very plain and simple: however, it is very difficult to rease a perfect bird. The varied and preferred colors of these birds are a very deep Black. Red. Tellow, Blue and Light Blue and a Blue and Vellow & Simple Yellow Stipple.

Tellow Stipple. As already stated, the modern Hel-met originated through the crossing with Reinaugen blood. Consequently, they must be carefully and correctly mated. If this is not done, the result will be extremely disadvantageous. Outstanding breeder knowledge is nec-essary, therefore, if one wishes to a-

vold disappointment. void disappointment. Since the above informathen from the "German Standard" was compiled some 25 years ago, it is possible that the present-day Helmat may be more steadfast in its markings. If so, then it will be much easier to breed them now than at that time.

now than at thist time. Description, Homeland, and Eletory (German Standard). The Helmst is a Tumbler bred in Hamburg for more than a bundred years. It originsted from the Kalotte (Piotentumbler) and the supreme Konigsberger Relakuge. Impression: Fetite, lovely, courset, 10-10 ½ inches long. Head: Round, sturing at the wattle a tight fisting round cap and fully de-veloped rosettes, or a plain head. EMI: Short and tightly closed: light horn colored; obtuse angle to the fore-head.

Byes. Pearl color, cere, small pale to pale red in color. Neck: Short and compact. Chest: Round and protruding.

Back, Straight, short with a little slant

Wings: Close to the body; the wing tips resting on the tail. Tail: Medium length and close to-

Belly: Short and wightly rounded. Legs: Clean. Color and Markings: Black, Red, Yel-

low, Blue and Silver.

Now, huse and Silver. The colored tail should be evenly colored underneath as well as on top, as if it were set in: the colored head-plate has to reach into the wells conp, and has to line up with the eyes and beak. The ground color is White. The same requirements are also made for the plain head.

Faults which do not exclude from the following awards are: Very Good: A small misinformation

Very Good: A small misinformation of the pupil. Good: A small misformation of the pupil; a misformation of rostites, if the upper part of the bill is gravy, and the color is not intensive. Faults that are unsatisfactory: White underneath the tail; unclear syms. Faults that exclude from awards: Dark eyes, white tail feathers, and black upper part of the bill.


