A reminder of by-gone days

Description of the German Helmet

By PAUL KAISER

Recent articles concerning Helmeta have brought back memories of the year 1894 when I had some Helmeta of my own. The city where I spent most of my life was only six miles from Hamburg; so we children bred the local varieties of Hamburgs. I never knew that they were called Plotten-

vold disappointment.

Since the above information from the "German Standard" was compiled some 25 years ago, it is possible that the present-day Helmeta may be more steadfast in its markings. If so, then it will be much easier to breed them now than at that time.

Description, Homeland, and History (German Standard.) The Helmeta is a Tumbler bred in Hamburg for more than a hundred years. It originated from the Kalotte (Ploctentumbler) and the supreme Konigsberger Reinsauge. Impression: Petite, lovely, compact, 10-10½ inches long.

Head: Round, starting at the wattle a tight fitting round cap and fully developed rosettes, or a plain head.

Bill: Short and tightly closed; light horn colored; obtuse angle to the forehead.

Eyes: Pearl color, cere, small pale to pale red in color.

Neck: Short and compact.

Chest: Round and protruding.

Back: Straight, short with a little slant.

Wings: Close to the body; the wing tips resting on the tail.

Tail: Medium length and close together.

Belly: Short and slightly rounded.

Legs: Clean.

Color and Markings: Black, Red, Yellow, Blue and Silver.

The colored tail should be evenly colored underneath as well as on top, as if it were set in; the colored head-plate has to reach into the white cap, and has to line up with the eyes and back. The ground color is white. The same requirements are also made for the plain head.

Faults which do not exclude from the following awards are:

Very Good: A small misformation of the pupil.

Good: A small misformation of the pupil; a misformation of rosettes, if the upper part of the bill is gray, and the color is not intensive.

Faults that are unsatisfactory: White underneath the tail; unclear eyes.

Faults that exclude from awards: Dark eyes, white tail feathers, and black upper part of the bill.

tumblers until I read a recent article, we always called them Calottes.

The first time I saw Short-Faced Helmeta, was in 1916, and I grew very fond of these nice looking birds, but they were very scarce and hard to get. In 1924, when I came to this country, I tried to bring some along, but they were still hard to get, so instead I brought my Stettiner Tumblers and Danziger Highfliers. After I read an article about Helmeta I wondered what the "German Standard" had to say about them, and discovered some very interesting information.

The Hamburger Calotte or Helmeta is a typical Hamburger Tumbler. His heritage goes back well over a century. This bird was preferred above all others in Hamburg and surrounding cities. The Short-Faced Helmeta, derived from the old-fashioned Ploctentumbler and the "Konigsberger Reinsauge", is especially notable in the air. Outstanding in flight performance, petite in body, and lively in action, it makes a very remarkable impression.


The markings look very plain and simple; however, it is very difficult to raise a perfect bird. The varied and preferred colors of these birds are a very deep Black, Red, Yellow, Blue and Light Blue and a Blue and Yellow Stipple.

As already stated, the modern Helmeta originated through the crossing with Reinsauge blood. Consequently, they must be carefully and correctly mated. If this is not done, the result will be extremely disadvantageous. Outstanding breeder knowledge is necessary, therefore, if one wishes to a-
